Intake Sessions

18 Months:

An accelerated programme starting in January based on students' IGCSE/O Level trial/actual results.

24 Months:

Begins in July and consists of 4 semesters overall. The intake of the students will be based on trial/actual SPM or mock/actual IGCSE/O Level results.



We're creating a vibe that makes college life more than just where you sleep and study but making every moment part of an awesome experience!












From top to bottom, left to right:




